2ND YEAR SYLLABUS

Know your Culture and How to Influence It

OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

The second-year curriculum is designed to help the student understand how to bring the Kingdom of God to their focused Sphere of Influence through a series of God given assignments. The curriculum will help students look at where they are at now and what God has for them where they are planted. Students will be further stretched in their God given gifts and encouraged to take risks and step out in prophecy, healing, words of knowledge, and evangelism. Students will not only be encouraged, stretched, and empowered in the supernatural, but they will also develop strategies and plans for where God has them and expanding vision for where He is sending them.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the year students will be able to

1. Cultivate a personal life of supernatural encounters with God through prayer, fasting, and worship.
2. Discern and interpret prophetic messages and demonstrate the ability to prophesy with biblical accuracy. Apply the prophetic to their lives, a communication tool to fulfill their assignment in expanding the kingdom.
3. Understand the biblical basis for their identity and its importance in expanding and experiencing the Kingdom in them and on the earth.
4. Identify and demonstrate various spiritual gifts and their functions.
5. Engage in effective evangelism and demonstrate the supernatural power of God in sharing the Gospel.
6. Comprehend the principles and practices of divine healing and engage in ministering healing to others as lead by the Holy Spirit.
7. Comprehend the seven spheres of influence and how it can empower them to affect culture to expand the kingdom.
8. Understand what sphere(s) of influence God has called them to participate in and begin to bring the Kingdom in their everyday life.

ASSESSMENT METHODS

- Class participation and engagement in discussions

- Practical demonstrations of spiritual gifts and ministry in the classroom and out in the world
- Willingness to push outside of your comfort zone
- Reading of class materials, books, and participation in class activations
